

Statement of Faith

1.1 Statement of Faith

- 1) We believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; on the third day, He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.
- 2) We believe in the Holy Spirit, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.
- 3) We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament are the inerrant, inspired word of God.
- 4) We believe that all have sinned and are therefore guilty before God and are under His condemnation outside of Jesus Christ.
- 5) We believe that all who receive the Holy Spirit are children of God, and that when the Holy Spirit indwells, He enlightens, guides, and enables the believer in life, repentance, testimony, and service.
- 6) We believe that God hears the prayers of His people and meets their needs according to His purpose.
- 7) We believe in the bodily resurrection.
- 8) We believe that all believers are called to a life of separation from all worldly and sinful practices and alliances.
- 9) We believe that all sexual activity outside of the biblical definition of marriage is in direct contradiction to God's Word and His intention for the institution of the family.
- 10) We believe that each human life is a gift from God, created in His image and likeness, and that only He has the authority to end an innocent human Life. We, therefore, believe in the sanctity of all innocent human Life from fertilization until natural death and oppose any and all means to destroy innocent human Life and to hasten death.
